RESOLUTION 2021-191

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Communications Commission has authorized the hiring of additional staff and the Board of Supervisors does not consider or appoint personnel for the Communications Commission, but needs to authorize payroll for the County Auditor. Clinton County Communications Director Eric Dau desires to appoint Bobbie Duncan as a Telecommunicator for the Clinton County Communications Commission; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa that the County Auditor be and is hereby authorized to issue biweekly paychecks on the Communications Commission Budget, to Duncan, as a full-time Telecommunicator. This will be in effect at an hourly rate of \$18.46 during the first 6 months of employment, then increasing to \$20.77 for the next 6 months of employment, and the increasing to \$23.08 after 1 year of employment. Duncan's starting date of employment with the Clinton County Communications Commission will be July 12, 2021. This is subject to the terms and conditions of the Clinton County Communications Commission Bargaining Unit agreement without further action of this Board.

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor Eric Van Lancker asked how the Board would like to handle its meeting schedule for the next couple of weeks considering the County Fair meeting on July 22. Van Lancker said his office is meeting later this week with city clerks and school secretaries in preparation of the Nov. 2 City/School Election. Van Lancker also said proposed legislation that would remove the weekends from 24 hour notice of a public meeting did not get approved during the last legislative session.

County Attorney Mike Wolf said the attorney's law software is starting to switch over and he thanked IT for their assistance.

County Sanitarian Shane McClintock said work has started on the wastewater project in Elvira and continues depending on the weather.

County Facilities Director Corey Johnson said the Administration Building parking lot project should start on Monday.

County Engineer Todd Kinney said minor repairs are being made on County roads for the upcoming Triathlon. He said repairs are also being made in preparation for RAGBRAI.

Supervisor Srp said a sub-committee to look at upgraded radio equipment for first responders will meet this week.

Supervisor Irwin said he is working with other entities and the Iowa Workforce region to request that the state's ARP funds for workforce issues be passed to the local entities to be better used for specific job trainings.

Chairman Determann said the US 30 Coalition is working with a firm on an economic development projection for a four-lane highway.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Secondary Road Lost Nation Shed Project Bids: County Engineer Todd Kinney reported the lowest bid came in more than \$186,000 over the budgeted amount. He recommends rejecting all the bids and set a time for a new bid letting. He recommends asking for bids in the fall and giving them basically a year to complete the work. He said material prices were dropping in June and delivery times are getting better. He said some bids were higher due to the shorter window to complete the job.

The following resolution was presented and on motion approved:

RESOLUTION 2021-199

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 26.3 requires that governmental entities follow the competitive bid process for vertical infrastructure projects with an estimated total cost that exceeds the competitive bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2021, at 10:00 AM bids were received for the construction of a new 138 by 45 feet clear span heated building; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of each bid received is as follows;

WHEREAS, the bids received are substantially in excess of the project budgeted funds; now
 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, concurs with the
 County Engineer's recommendation that the bids be rejected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with Iowa Code Section 26.10 a new date for receiving
 bids be selected and publication of a new notice to bidders by the County Engineer.

RAGBRAI update: Kinney said City of Clinton wants to detour traffic onto county road 220th Street and 380th
 Avenue for RAGBRAI at the end of the month. The City needs County approval to submit the detour to the Iowa
 DOT.

MOTION by Supervisor Srp to approve the detouring of vehicular traffic from Hwy 136 and U.S. 67 on to County
 road 220th Street and 380th Avenue to accommodate RAGBRAI.

County Administration Building Generator Update: Johnson said the firm could visit the site and review the two
 options previously discussed. He said it will take about 32 hours of work to complete the study. He said the
 estimated study cost is \$5,800.

MOTION by Supervisor Srp to authorize Mead & Hunt to conduct a study to research options for the County
 Administration Building generator.

Outside Agency Funding: Van Lancker said there were second-half allocations that were not made since there were
 not signed agreements with many of the non-profits as recommended by the State Auditor's Office. He asked for
 direction for the current fiscal year for funding non-profits. Wolf said it has to be stated that it would support
 economic development. He agreed there needs to be agreements that have to include certain thresholds and a report
 on those thresholds being met. Van Lancker offered to work through the list with the budget director and Wolf and
 provide the Board recommendations. Srp said he would like recommendations from that group as they have been
 working to understand those rules.

Grants for the Clinton County Resource Center: Irwin said if grants are found, the Board may be asked to approve a
 grant or provide matching funds. Irwin and County Sheriff Greenwalt said some of the grants have a quick
 turnaround. Greenwalt would like to know what the Supervisors may approve for grants. Srp said the Board should
 know about matching funds and if the grant is to add a staff position.

American Rescue Plan Funds Update: Van Lancker said he and Budget Director Nicholas Manrique have been
 collecting projects from department heads that could be funded by the "lost revenues" portion of the ARP. He said
 that list has been compiled and will be sent to the Supervisors. He said Supervisors continue to send him and
 Manrique various articles about ARP spending. He suggested the Board figure out a plan how to spend the ARP
 funds. Determann would like to wait until after the ISAC conference in August. Irwin said in the meeting he had
 with school superintendents, they wondered if they could use those funds. Irwin also suggested they meet with
 municipalities to see how they are using their funds. He suggested a consultant could help organize that
 conversation. Srp said there may be things the County needs before committing too much to outside agencies. It was
 agreed to review the ARP topic again during the Board's Aug. 2 meeting.
