Coronavirus/COVID-19 update: County Community Health Manager Michele Cullen was not available for the meeting, but provided a written report stating there were 153 new cases last week. She reported the region hospitalizations were at 97 with Genesis at 26 and Mercy with four. The positivity rate was at 12.8% and the vaccination rate in the County was at 50.8%.

### DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor Eric Van Lancker reported that this afternoon he and the GIS staff will review the recently scanned documents from ArcaSearch as they are close to being ready for release. Van Lancker said he received an update from the State Defenders office and they will not have a person in the Clinton County office until May. He reminded the Board it is not planning on meeting November 29.

Supervisor Irwin said the Workforce Development region met last week and the State of Iowa has more than 88,000 jobs available listed in its system with 66% of Iowans on unemployment. He said that demonstrates there are more jobs than workers. He said Clinton County was pointed out as a good example of attracting resident through programs like Home Base Iowa. He said area daycares are having issues staffing which is causing shorter operation hours.

Chairman Determann said the Highway 30 Coalition is starting to put numbers together to be in a position to take advantage of some of the state's portion of the federal infrastructure dollars.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson reported for FY 2020 \$1.2 million is uncollected for the first half payment of property tax and \$290,000 is outstanding from the Confucius Academy property. He said there is still \$418,000 outstanding on the 2019 property tax collections with a large amount of that being from the academy. He said overall the academy owes more than \$873,000 over three tax years in property tax payments. He said he did speak recently with an escrow company about the property.

County Facilities Director Corey Johnson reported the administration building bathroom bids are due tomorrow and he will report the results during next week's meeting.

County Engineer Todd Kinney said the old Highway 30 project has been suspended until the surface temperature increases and hopes that will be tomorrow. Kinney said the environmental impact study for the old Highway 30 bridge near Wheatland is currently underway.

### DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Solar Project Update: County Planning and Zoning Director Thomas Barnes said the County Attorney Mike Wolf and Irwin will be meeting with an engineering firm to discuss options it can provide for the County. Irwin said there was another firm in St. Louis that they are also talking with. Rebecca Griebel, county resident, said it is hard to find information on solar because it is newer industry. She said Hawkeye Solar leaves little appealing to the land owner. She has been offered landscaping including a tree line. She said people won't want to buy a home in the middle of a solar field. Griebel said a North Carolina project said the production is intermittent; so she wondered why farm land would be taken out of production for something that only produces 20% of the time. She also said she has found studies that showed property value could decrease by 12.5%.

**10:30 A.M. Broadband Study and Grants Update**

SmartSource representatives Curtis Dean and Todd Kielkopf reviewed the resolution that was sent to the Board last week for their review. Irwin wondered about meeting with the providers and is worried about committing funds to broadband now that the rules for the usage of the funds have been loosened. Dean said the providers meeting with the Board may not be as productive as the Board would like because they may not want to share certain information in a public meeting. Keilkopf said they would like to continue the process of the survey. He said the resolution would set criteria by which the County may invest in a broadband improvement project. SmartSource will get feedback from providers about the criteria and report back to the Board next week.
