The Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, met. Present were Supervisors Determann, Irwin and Srp. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

9:00 A.M. Review Correspondence and Claims Call to Order – Pledge of Allegiance

9:15 A.M. Formal Action & Motions Claims were approved unanimously

Coronavirus/COVID-19 update: Clinton Community Health Manager Michele Cullen reported there were 136 new cases compared to 322 last week. She added the home rapid tests are not included. She said there are 167 hospitalizations in Region 5; Genesis has 24 and Mercy with six. Cullen said those numbers are trending down. She reported the positivity rate is 17.4% which is down from 25.9% last week. The vaccination rate for Clinton County is 55.6%. Cullen said she will continue to report, but after next week some numbers will no longer be available as the state emergency proclamation is coming to an end.

He added a small group met on Friday morning to discuss a JAG grant for the Resource Center to contract with an outside agency to have a person in the Resource Center on a daily basis and coordinate some of the activities.

Area Substance Abuse Council Update: Candace Seitz, ASAC director of prevention, reviewed a report she shared with the Board of Supervisors. Seitz also requested Clinton County support the application for the fourth and final year of the JAG grant for the project to address the current rate of youth nicotine use in Clinton County, especially through the use of electronic nicotine devices.
