RESOLUTION 2022-338

WHEREAS, the residents of Clinton County have great respect, admiration, and the utmost gratitude for all of the men and women who have selflessly served our country and this community in the Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, the contributions and sacrifices of the men and women who served in the Armed Forces have been vital in maintaining the freedoms and way of life enjoyed by our citizens; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County seeks to honor these individuals who have paid the high price for freedom by placing themselves in harm's way for the good of all; and

WHEREAS, Veterans continue to serve our community in the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, AMVETS, religious groups, civil service, and by functioning as Clinton County Veteran Service Officers to help the Veterans of Clinton County access more than \$1,112,000 disability and compensation benefits each month; and

WHEREAS, approximately 200,000 service members transition to civilian communities annually; and

WHEREAS, an estimated 20 percent increase of service members will transition to civilian life in the near future; and

WHEREAS, studies indicate that 44-72 percent of service members experience high levels of stress during the transition from military to civilian life; and

WHEREAS, Active Military Service Members transitioning from military service are at high risk for suicide during their first year after military service; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties and the National Association of County Veteran Service Officers encourage all counties, parishes and boroughs to recognize Operation Green Light for Veterans; and

WHEREAS, Clinton County appreciates the sacrifices of our United States Military Personnel and believes specific recognition should be granted; now

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor Eric Van Lancker said in-person absentee voting continues this week in the Administration Building and will also be open on Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. He said satellite voting in DeWitt went well and all the voters were thankful for that opportunity. He reminded the Board the canvass of votes will be scheduled for Nov. 15.

Supervisor Srp said the Community College reached out about possible tours of County facilities for students doing career research. He said that is taking place on Thursday.

Chairman Determann said they attended the CTE facility opening, and it will be a benefit to students in Clinton County. He said the one in DeWitt will open next September.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson said delinquent notices have been sent and his office has received phone calls about them. He said they average 2.3% out of county titling per week. He added with the Enterprise work it is more than 13%, but they are changing the addresses on those to make the reissues happen in Clinton County.

County Engineer Todd Kinney reported Z-40 is completed. He said 255th Street paving will begin today and will be the last paving project of the year. He said the Lost Nation and Elwood sheds are moving forward.

County Veterans Affairs Director Joe Raaymakers said he has now been in this position a little more than a year. He said the new office offers privacy and is working well. He's digitized many files and has gone paperless on all new claims. He hopes the VA can move toward more electronic signatures. He said he has completed all his accreditations. He has been able to take a laptop and visit people who can't leave their homes or nursing homes. Raaymakers said claims have increased lately meaning more federal VA funds are helping Clinton County veterans. He thanked his part-time staff for their work in DeWitt and also thanked Van Lancker and the IT Department for their assistance during the past year.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Juvenile Detention Update: County Attorney Mike Wolf and Addie Rupp, Juvenile Court Officer for Clinton and Jackson County, explained juveniles' must now be placed in a juvenile detention center according to a new law that was implemented in December of last year. They said that means detention centers are filling up. He said the detention center they have used charge \$200-\$400 a day. Wolf said they have had one transferred to Linn County. He said Linn County has been doing a good job for Clinton County's juvenile detentions. He said Linn County can handle difficult detainees. Rupp said there is a detention issue. The Scott County facility will help with this matter, but it won't be completed for more than year from now. She added the Linn County facility has been good to work with and they will allow Clinton County to reserve two beds at \$282 per bed, per day whether they are used or not. Wolf said that's about \$102,000 for the rest of the fiscal year. Rupp said Linn County is willing to meet to discuss a contract for the rest of the fiscal year 2023. Rupp said she does recommend Clinton County enter an agreement with the Linn County facility. Rupp said Central Iowa Detention Center continually asks Clinton County to transport out their detainees and its usually at the worst times. Srp said he's not sure he can support reserving two beds but would consider a deal for one bed. Wolf said they are using an average of at least one bed a day for this fiscal year. Rupp will provide more information to the Supervisors for them to consider Linn County. County Sheriff Bill Greenwalt said the Central Iowa program has turned out to be disappointing. He said he would like to make sure any deals are vetted out better than how the Central Iowa proposal was presented. Greenwalt suggested a small task force to review this matter. Rupp said any deal the County makes should include a rate that doesn't change, and their detainees can't be kicked out.
