

Supervisor Irwin said he also attended the pipeline meeting and it appears that Wolf is trying hard to work with landowners and government agencies.

Chairman Determann said he went to the ISAC Supervisors District 6 meeting and Jackson County Supervisor Mike Steines will be the new president.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson said the old Ashford property is more than \$1.2 million due in taxes and assessments. He said that will eclipse \$1.3 million after this year's liabilities are added to the outstanding.

County Engineer Todd Kinney said his department will be hiring two positions due to retirements.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

County Funding of Transitional Housing Support: Van Lancker said the Board earlier in the year agreed to continue to fund the match for the FEMA assistance for transitional housing through December. He said the Board will need to decide how long to continue this funding. Regan Michelson, IRAS, said they have requests daily from people who have no place to go and there is no other option but this program. She said the winter weather will make it worse. She believes if this is not extended, she is concerned there will be a lot of people trying to live outside in the winter weather. Angie Bloomfield, with the YWCA, agreed with that assessment. IRAS will allow them two weeks in the program and the YWCA will allow them to stay longer. Bloomfield said the lack of affordable housing in the community makes it difficult to help transition out of the program. Irwin said he would support extending the County's financial support for the programs. Srp said he will support but believes the City of Clinton should also be participating in the program as well. Irwin said one of the top issues the Mental Health region is dealing with is homelessness. A resolution to continue the County commitment will be on next week's agenda.

Juvenile Detention Update: County Attorney Mike Wolf said there are currently two in detention and one in the jail, sight and sound separated. He said a juvenile issue did come up over the weekend, but there were no beds available. He said other services were used in the place of detention. Wolf said Clinton County is not the only County facing this issue. Wolf said he is also meeting with law enforcement from around the County to talk about transportation of juveniles.

10:13 A.M. Public Hearing – Drainage Districts

MOTION by Supervisor Srp to recess as the Board of Supervisors and convene as the Board of Trustees for Drainage District #17.

Roll Call: Srp: Yes; Irwin: Yes; Determann: Yes. Motion carried. The Board of Trustees for Drainage District #17 convened at 10:13 a.m.

County Engineer Todd Kinney reviewed the repair request he received. He said there are two areas that are being reviewed. One section needs to be investigated to see if the bank failed and caused tile damage or the other way around. He said the other location includes an outlet area away from the ditch. He said the outlet drain is just short of the ditch and has caused some erosion. Kinney said he believes that's a landowner issue. He said the trustees need to decide if this is an owner issue or drainage district issue. He said both repairs would be less than \$1,500 each and his crew could take care of it. He said anything above \$1,500 would require a public hearing. Irwin and Srp believe the drain that falls short of the ditch should be repaired by the landowner. Srp said the district should repair the other section where it appears the bank may have failed.

MOTION by Supervisor Srp to authorize the County Engineer to repair 1,500 feet south or 220th Street and that the Engineer notify the landowner of the denial of the repair request for the matter 1,000 feet south 220th Street.
