The Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, met. Present were Supervisors Irwin, Srp and George. Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Chairman Irwin called a public hearing to order to solicit public comment on the County’s proposed tax levy rates.

Present were the Board of Supervisors, County Auditor Eric Van Lancker, County Budget Director, County Treasurer, County Assessor, public and media.

Proof of publication was presented, accepted and returned for filing.

The tax levy statements were reviewed to explain the information that was provided on the notice.

Jerry Kedley, county resident, asked about what was covered by the county levy and how the assessed values are figured into the property tax calculations. He suggested the Board goes back to the State officials and share with them that the information should be better explained. Chris Victory, Clinton resident, said his taxes have gone up since he became a homeowner and is concerned about his taxes going up while he lives next to a dilapidated piece of property. Mark Forney, Camanche resident, had questions about how his property is assessed as his property assessment realized a large increase. Discussion took place about how properties are assessed and credits that are available.
